


Be a Missionary in Armenia!

In Matthew 28:19, it says, "Therefore go and make disciples of all nations, baptizing them in the name of the Father and of the Son and of the Holy Spirit". Let's see if we can travel across Armenia...



"Be a Missionary in Armenia!" Game Rules

What You Will Need

One die (two dice are not recommended as they may considerably shorten game time) and game pieces. You may create game pieces using stickers or other craft pieces, or you may borrow both the die and game pieces from another board game.

Objective

Traveling in either direction, the first person to Yerevan wins.

How to Play

1. Roll the die to determine how many spaces to move.
2. If you land on a blank space, wait for your next turn.
3. If you land on a space with a fish or a net or a campfire, you will need to refer to the section "game questions" for details on either a question to answer or an instruction to follow.
4. You can move either forward or backward based on the instructions received.
5. If a question cannot be answered or is answered incorrectly, stay in your space.
6. If a question is answered correctly, you may continue your turn unless:
 - a. You land on a blank space;
 - b. Receive instructions that say "lose a turn";
 - c. Receive instructions that ask you to move backwards.

If You Land On a Fish:



1. What is an apostle? Move ahead 1 space.
2. Who were Thaddeus and Bartholomew? Move ahead 2 spaces.
3. What was Bartholomew's other name? Move ahead 1 space.
4. What was today's Verse-A-Long? Move ahead 4 if you can say the verse (including the passage where it is from); move ahead 2 if you know either the verse or can say which passage it is from.
5. What was the King's name? Move ahead 1 space.
6. Who was the King's daughter? Move ahead 2 spaces.
7. Besides Armenia, name one other country that Thaddeus and Bartholomew visited. For each country you name, move ahead 1 space; there are three countries in total.

If You Land On a Net:



1. In the context of our story today, someone who actually knew Jesus Christ is called _____. Move ahead 1 space.
2. They were the apostles in our story today. Move ahead 2 spaces.
3. Nathaniel was his other name. Move ahead 1 space.
4. This is our memory verse for next week. Move ahead 4 if you can say the verse (including the passage where it is from); move ahead 2 if you know either the verse or can say which passage it is from.
5. Sanadroug was the name of the _____ in our story today. Move ahead 1 space.
6. Santoukhd was the name of the _____ in our story today. Move ahead 2 spaces.
7. Who went to India, Persia and Arabia as well as Armenia to preach God's word? Move ahead 1 space.

If You Land On a Campfire:



1. You fell into Lake Sevan, move back 3.
2. You detoured into Ararat, move back 2.
3. You preached to the crowd at Etchmiadzin and they believed in Jesus, move ahead 3.
4. You found a camel along the way, move ahead 1.
5. It got dark and you had to stay overnight, lose a turn.
6. You fell off the donkey's back, move back 3.
7. You preached to King Sanadroug but he wasn't ready to hear the message, move back 1.
