



Dear Supporter of the AEUNA,

As we approach the end of the year, I want to share with you an exciting new method to support the ongoing ministries of the AEUNA. Besides accepting gifts through checks, the Union is now able to accept gifts of securities, including stocks, bonds and mutual funds.

**Example:** Bob and Sally Smithian purchased 50 shares of ABC mutual fund in 1991 at a cost of \$1,000. Over time it has appreciated to \$10,000. The Smiths are in a 25% federal income tax bracket and God has led them to give \$10,000 to the AEUNA this year. They have always given cash, but want to make their gift tax efficient.

Options	Gift Value	Charitable Contribution Allowed	Income Tax Savings	Total Tax Savings
Give Cash	\$10,000	\$10,000	\$2,500	\$2,500
Give Securities	\$10,000	\$10,000	\$2,500 + \$1350 In cap gains tax avoidance	\$3,850

Please prayerfully consider a gift of securities to the AEUNA. One area of AEUNA ministry that has been thriving has been the Armenian Evangelical Youth Fellowship (AEYF.) The AEYF now hosts nine faith based conferences throughout the year; God is using and blessing this ministry to draw young people to life-changing faith in Jesus Christ.

In the gospel of Mark 12:41-43, Jesus notices and highlights the sacrificial nature of the widow's offering: "I tell you the truth, this poor widow has put more into the treasury than all of the others. They all gave out of their wealth, but she, out of her poverty, put in everything, all she had to live on." What Jesus asks us to focus on is not the absolute amount of her gift, but the fact that relative to her means she gave freely and with a sacrificial attitude.
