Speaker



We are very excited to have Nairy Ohanian, D.Min. MATS as our keynote speaker. Over the course of three sessions she will cover understanding the Biblical perspective, walking alongside, and remaining resilient in the midst of suffering.

Dr. Nairy Ohanian is a Cross Cultural Pastoral Counselor, serving with Barnabas International. Most recently she lived in Egypt, and served throughout the Middle East North Africa region. Currently she is residing near Washington, DC. and traveling globally as needed. She has served as

a mission worker for 30 years in various countries around the world, including many years in Armenia and Turkey.

Nairy was involved in university student outreach and church planting before serving in pastoral care for ministry leaders. Today Nairy provides training and counseling for leaders as they go through various challenges and stages of their calling. She teaches and writes articles on issues such as; Stress and Burnout, Cultural Adjustment, Grief, Loss and Suffering, Transitions, Singleness, Healthy Families, Sabbath Rest, Work Life Balance, Ministry Failure, Self-Care, Loneliness, and Spiritual Rhythms. Nairy earned her masters at Gordon-Conwell Theological Seminary and her doctorate degree from Columbia International University in South Carolina.

She enjoys teaching and has traveled to over 50 countries. She published a book entitled "Now, Can you Trust Me?" about her daily life lessons learned while living in Armenia. When Nairy is not in an airplane or counseling she enjoys fitness, biking, painting watercolors, keeping her cactus plants alive and strolling through art museums.
